Bag - Tips and Hints



Preparations

Draw a circle in the size you want your bag. Divide the circle in two. Draw a second half circle inside the first one to create the handle.

Select different fabrics and leather materials for your bag. For best result use fabrics with similar thickness.

Bag front

Sew all pieces together and decorate them before you cut after the pattern.

Make the decoration flower using the circular attachment* template. Decorate the flower with a stitch of your choice, we used 5.1.8.

Use fusible web to attach the flower to the bag and sew it in place using a dense zigzag stitch.

Decorate the front of the bag with stitches sewn in parallel lines with an even distance using the Clear ¼ Inch Quilting foot for IDT™ System (820926096)*.

Cut out the front piece for the bag and attach heavy weight fusible batting to it to make a bag with hard cover.

Other embellishments

Use one of the built in Alphabets and a decorative stitch to make your own name tag. We used the Comic alphabet and stitch no. 4.2.11.

Create a tassel for the bag using a piece of leather that matches the bag. Cut out a square piece and cut out fringes as shown in the illustration 5mm apart.

Mounting

Attach heavy weight fusible batting to all parts of the bag before assembling the bag. Choose a fabric that matches the rest of the bag and make a piping around the bag and the handles. For best result, use the Piping foot (820532096).* Attach the zipper to the part that will be the opening for the bag before sewing it to the front and back piece of the bag.
