## 1 cutting

$6 \mathrm{~mm}(1 / 4$ ") seam allowance included

## Dark red batik

2 pieces $-35.5 \times 46 \mathrm{~cm}(14 " \times 18$ ") piecing 2 pieces $-12.5 \times 21.5 \mathrm{~cm}\left(5^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ piecing $150 \times 150 \mathrm{~cm}\left(59 " \times 59^{\prime \prime}\right)$ quilt back, join if necessary

## Purple batik

4 pieces $-7.5 \times 35.5 \mathrm{~cm}\left(3^{\prime \prime} \times 14\right.$ ") piecing 4 pieces $-9 \times 35.5 \mathrm{~cm}\left(31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}\right)$ piecing

## Light purple batik

4 pieces $-7.5 \times 35.5 \mathrm{~cm}\left(3^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}\right)$ piecing 4 pieces - $11.5 \times 46 \mathrm{~cm}\left(41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18\right.$ ") piecing 2 pieces $-9 \times 21.5 \mathrm{~cm}\left(31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ piecing

## Pink batik

4 pieces $-12.5 \times 21.5 \mathrm{~cm}\left(5^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ piecing 4 pieces $-9 \times 21.5 \mathrm{~cm}\left(31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ piecing 2 pieces $-11.5 \times 42 \mathrm{~cm}\left(41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 161 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ piecing
Red/pink patterned fabric with circles 2 pieces - $19 \times 21.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ (71/2" x 8 1/2") piecing

## Yellow patterned fabric

4 pieces - $19 \times 21.5 \mathrm{~cm}\left(71 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2\right.$ ") piecing

Pinklyellow patterned fabric with squares 4 pieces - $15.5 \times 19 \mathrm{~cm}(6 " \times 71 / 2$ ") piecing

## Black/white checked fabric

4 pieces $-14 \times 16.5 \mathrm{~cm}\left(51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ piecing
1 piece - $28 \times 33 \mathrm{~cm}\left(11^{\prime \prime} \times 13^{\prime \prime}\right)$ piecing
Black
2 pieces - $5 \times 42 \mathrm{~cm}\left(2^{\prime \prime} \times 16\right.$ 1/ ${ }^{\prime \prime}$ )
2 pieces - $5 \times 35.5 \mathrm{~cm}\left(2^{\prime \prime} \times 14\right.$ ")
8 pieces $-4 \times 21.5 \mathrm{~cm}\left(11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$
8 pieces - $4 \times 19 \mathrm{~cm}\left(11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$
4 pieces $-7.5 \times 150 \mathrm{~cm}\left(3^{\prime \prime} \times 59\right.$ ") borders
4 pieces $-6 \times 150 \mathrm{~cm}\left(2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 59^{\prime \prime}\right)$ binding

## Batting

## 2 Sewing

- Refer to the layout designs for the placement of the piecing squares and rectangles.
- Attach the $1 / 4$ " quilting foot to your ClassicStyle Quilt sewing machine. Thread your sewing machine with neutral cotton sewing thread on the top and in the bobbin. Stitch the squares and rectangles together in rows from left to right according to the layout design, using a straight stitch and a $6 \mathrm{~mm}(1 / 4$ ") seam allowance. Press the seam allowance to the dark coloured fabric. Sew the rows together as per the layout design.
- Press the fusible bias tape over the ditches (seam lines). Start with the diagonals and then follow with the verticals and finish with the horizontal seams. Sew with black embroidery thread a straight stitch in the middle of the tape to secure the bias tape.
- Sew on the black borders. Place the black strips, $7,5 \mathrm{~cm}\left(3^{\prime \prime}\right)$ wide, right side together with the quilt and sew a straight stitch. Press the seam allowance to the edges.
- Make a quilt sandwich with the quilt backing face down on the table, the batting on top and then the quilt front right side up. Secure the layers with safety pins.


## 3 Quilting

- Quilt the large light purple rectangles with straight stitches on the diagonal. Use matching light purple sewing thread.
- Quilt rectangles with a straight stitch in the black checked pieces. Quilt the rectangles with $1 \mathrm{~cm}(3 / 8$ ") spacing. Use black sewing thread.
- Attach the Free-motion quilt foot and set up your Pfaff ClassicStyle Quilt sewing machine for free-motion stitching. Stipple stitch on the dark red batik and yellow patterned pieces. Use matching dark red and yellow thread.
- Embellish the quilt with different quilt stitches. We used black embroidery thread and stitch number 31, 37, 38 and 40 from the Pfaff ClassicStyle Quilt. Sew the stitches beside the ditch.
- Sew straight stitches with black embroidery thread, with a presser foot space in between, on the black edges around the quilt.
- Bind the quilt with the black strip, 6 cm $(2,5 ")$ wide. Fold the strips lengthwise wrong sides together and press. Place the strip with raw edges and right sides together with the backside of the quilt. Attach with a straight stitch and press to the edge. Fold the strip around the raw edges to the front side of the quilt. Stitch together near the edge from the front side.
